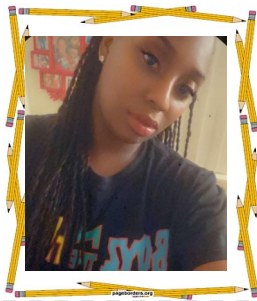

SCHOOLHOUSE REMINDERS

- ◆ Students are encouraged to keep a light sweater in the classroom for comfort due to the A/C.

- ◆ If your child is sick, you will have to provide a doctor's note specifying when they can return to school.
